A new Patrol car has been ordered and should be receiving the vehicle in mid-October. Mayor Evans commended the Village Police Department for there dedication and hard work.

Dustin Long DPW Supervisor stated that the DPW was working on sanitary survey report there were multiple citations received from NYS DEC. Dustin stated they are working on all crucial citations first and all

deadline requirements will be met. Spray foam is being completed in the well house; weather had been a factor in the hold of completion.

DPW supervisor Dustin Long submitted a request to the Village Board to purchase a replacement of the woodstove that is located in the DPW garage. The quote is from local business Rambling Ranch the stove burn with out refilling for 15 hours and will save the Village on the gas bill for the garage. The Village has wood from downed trees due to storms at no cost minus laborer. The Village of Portville Board agreed to the purchase of the Fire Chief FC1700E Wood burning Stove; invoice including venting, stove pipe, wall damper, flashing, and installation totaling \$5,465.16
